

AUSTRALIAN WEIGHTLIFTING FEDERATION INC MASTERS COMMITTEE

Terms of Reference

Preamble

These Terms of Reference are in recognition of the fact that while the strategic direction and evaluation of the Masters Committee is the responsibility of AWF Board of Directors, the day-to-day operational aspects of the Committee will be the responsibility of its Chairman and AWF Chief Executive Officer.

Objects of the Committee

The Masters Committee shall:

- Develop recommendations for ratification by the Board of Directors concerning the implementation of the Masters Program;
- Plan, manage, report and assist the nominated State to deliver the annual AWF Masters Championships;
- Recommend to the Board of Directors, the nomination of athletes and key support personnel relating to the participation at IWF Masters Championships;
- Recommend to the Board of Directors, the nomination of technical officials relating to IWF Masters Championships.
- Manage and disseminate to state members, on a periodical basis, the AWF Masters records.
- Conduct an annual meeting with State Masters Coordinators and other relevant officers and/or authorities.

Membership

The Masters Committee shall consist of:

- Nominated or qualified member
- Nominated AWF Masters Record Keeper
- One member of each state / territory association; being the State Masters Coordinator

The Masters Committee may also co-opt ex-officio members such as the AWF Chief Executive Officer and the OWF Masters Chairman.

Reporting

The AWF will provide administrative assistance for all meetings including maintenance of minutes.

A copy of the minutes will be distributed, as required to the AWF Board of Directors.

The Committee will provide a written report to the Annual General Meeting of the Federation, as appropriate, on the nature and results of its activities.

Spokespersons

The spokespersons for the Masters Committee shall be the AWF Masters Chairman and the AWF Chief Executive Officer.
