

# AUSTRALIAN WEIGHTLIFTING FEDERATION INC MEDICAL COMMITTEE

## Terms of Reference

### **Preamble**

These Terms of Reference are in recognition of the fact that while the strategic direction and evaluation of the Medical Committee is the responsibility of AWF Board of Directors, the day-to-day operational aspects of the Committee will be the responsibility of its Chairman and AWF Chief Executive Officer.

### **Objectives of the Committee**

The Medical Committee shall:

- Develop recommendations for ratification by the Board of Directors concerning the implementation of the Medical Program;
- Plan, manage, deliver and report on the operational aspects of athlete screening, medical examinations and other related tests in preparation of International events or during National team camps.
- Recommend to the Board of Directors, the nomination of medical personnel as team support officers for International Events;
- Recommend to the Board of Directors, the nomination of medical personnel as International Technical Officials for International Events;
- Plan, coordinate and report on the medical officers responsible for the management and supervision of National Championships.

### **Membership**

The Medical Committee shall consist of:

- Nominated or qualified Medical Officer
- Nominated or qualified member
- Nominated or qualified member

The Medical Committee may also co-opt ex-officio members such as the AWF Chief Executive Officer.

### **Reporting**

The AWF will provide administrative assistance for all meetings including maintenance of minutes.

A copy of the minutes will be distributed, as required to the AWF Board of Directors.

The Committee will provide a written report to the Annual General Meeting of the Federation, as appropriate, on the nature and results of its activities.

### **Spokesperson**

The spokesperson for the Medical Committee shall be its Chairman and the AWF Chief Executive Officer.
