Terms of Reference

Preamble

These Terms of Reference are in recognition of the fact that while the strategic direction and evaluation of the Technical Committee is the responsibility of AWF Board of Directors, the day-to-day operational aspects of the Committee will be the responsibility of its Chairman and the AWF Chief Executive Officer.

Objectives of the Committee

The Technical Committee shall:

- Develop recommendations for ratification by the Board of Directors concerning the implementation of the Technical Committee objectives, as set and in accordance with the International Weightlifting Federation (IWF).
- Plan, manage, deliver and report on the technical aspects of the annual Australian U15, U17, U20 and Open Championships;
- Recommend to the Board of Directors, the nomination of technical officials relating to the participation at International Weightlifting Events;
- Plan, manage and deliver, in conjunction with state members, the course promotion of technical officials from club to national accreditation status.
- Plan, manage and deliver the course promotion of technical officials from National to Category 2 to Category 1 accreditation status.

Membership

The Technical Committee shall consist of:

- Nominated or qualified member (Chair)
- Nominated of qualified members from state / territory associations

The Technical Committee may also co-opt ex-officio members such as the AWF Chief Executive Officer.

Reporting

The AWF will provide administrative assistance for all meetings including maintenance of minutes.

A copy of the minutes will be distributed, as required to the AWF Board of Directors.

The Committee will provide a written report to the Annual General Meeting of the Federation, as appropriate, on the nature and results of its activities.

Spokesperson

The spokesperson for the Technical Committee shall be its Chairman and the AWF Chief Executive Officer.
